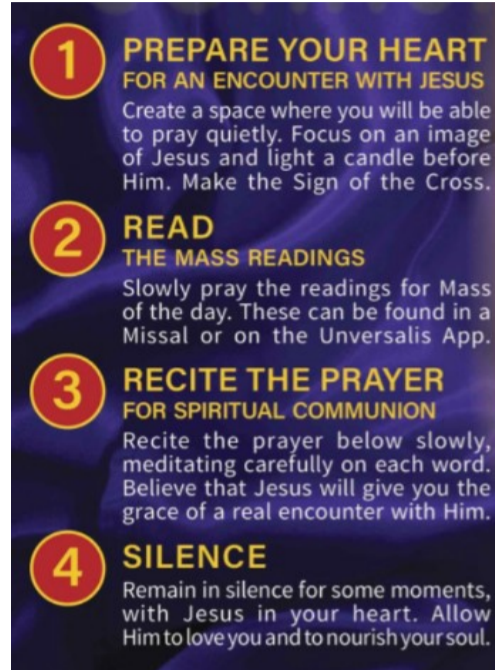

HOW TO MAKE AN ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION



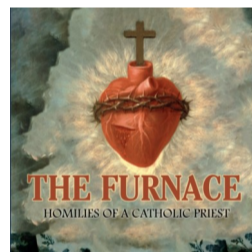
SPIRITUAL COMMUNION PRAYER

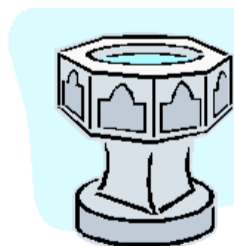
